

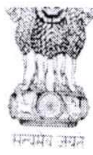
The nominated Judicial Officer is directed to observe following instructions:-


