About Us:

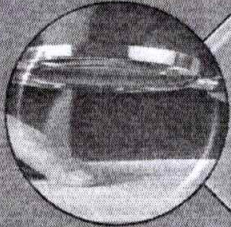

During over 51 years of its existence, the Institute has made significant headway in the areas of training of Criminal Justice Functionaries and Forensic Scientists, as well as research in applied aspects of the twin subjects.
