6. The participation of all the Judicial Officers, including the Judges posted in Family Court and Secretary, DLSA, of the district(s) is mandatory except for those officers who are deputed for remand duty/ urgent Civil & Criminal work by the Principal District & Sessions Judge of the concerned district(s) in accordance with the aforementioned table. A separate training will be imparted to such Judicial Officers of the State who have been entrusted with urgent work.

The Principal District & Sessions Judges shall ensure the participation of the Judges posted in their respective districts, in the Course.

7. The participant Judges should not seek any exemption unless it is a case of *vis-major*.
8. The Principal District & Sessions Judges of the districts, where the course is being held shall communicate the venue to the participants.
9. The participant Judges (except from District Headquarters where the Course is being conducted) shall be entitled for reimbursement of Travelling Allowance as per entitlement under the Rules from their district establishment.

Budgetary allocation for reimbursement of TA/fuel expenses of participant judges from the respective districts has already been made to all the Principal District and Sessions Judges of the State.

10. The Principal District & Sessions Judge in whose district the Course is conducted shall make all payments within seven days of the programme and forward the details with copies of bills to the Director, MPSJA.

**In-service/Mid-career Judicial Educational Programme
"Training Courses on – New Criminal Laws, 2023"**

Introduction:

After the enforcement of the New Criminal Laws, 2023; the Indian Penal Code, 1860, the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and the Indian Evidence Act, 1872 will be replaced with Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS, 2023), Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS, 2023) and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam, 2023 (BSA, 2023). Hence, Madhya Pradesh State Judicial Academy proposes to organize special **Courses on – New Criminal Laws, 2023**.

Objective/Theme:

The Judicial Officers of the State have to be sensitized regarding the objective behind enactment of the New Criminal Laws, its key provisions and application of the new provisions by all the stakeholders. The main goal is to make sure that all Judicial Officers understand these new laws well, what these laws aim to do, what they say and how to use them correctly in their work. Apart that, for preparing them to face any new challenges these laws might bring.

Methodology:

For conducting various training programmes, the Academy utilizes the services of certain Judicial Officers as Resource Persons. In the beginning, these Judicial Officers may be imparted two days **Training of Trainers Course on – New Criminal Laws, 2023** in the Academy so that with their skill, they can percolate their knowledge to other Judicial Officers of the State.

Thenceforth, their services may be utilized by the Academy for imparting training on the subject to all the Judicial Officers of the State at their district headquarters. These Courses may be organized on closed Saturdays/Sundays/

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holidays so as to avoid dislocation of Court working. If required, training to the Judicial Officers of two or more districts may be imparted together at any one district headquarters/location.

The Course Programme is submitted for approval as under:

Target Group:

All the Judicial Officers of the State.

Date & Duration:

- **Training of Trainers Course on – New Criminal Laws, 2023** may be conducted on **16.03.2024 & 17.03.2024** (two days) in the Academy.
- Training Courses at district headquarters may be conducted on Saturdays/Sundays/holidays (one day).

Nomination:

The Director, MPSJA shall submit a proposal for nomination of participant Judges to the Course. Order of nomination may be issued by the Registrar General/Competent Authority, High Court of Madhya Pradesh.

Venue:

Madhya Pradesh State Judicial Academy, Jabalpur (for ToT programme) and for the remaining Courses, the Court premises or any other suitable place finalized by the District & Sessions Judge of the concerned district.

In case the Course is conducted online or through other modes of telecommunication, the venue shall be the Court premises at respective place of postings at the end of the participant Judges.

Expenses and budgetary allocation:

(1) Estimated Expenditure: Fund may be allocated on the basis of number of Judicial Officers posted in the concerned district. Estimated

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expenditure for conducting the said programme for approximately 50 participants is calculated as under:

(2) Allocation of funds:

(i) The Principal District & Sessions Judges of the State may be allocated the requisite funds proportionate to the number of Judicial Offices posted in a particular district as per the proposed expenditure shown above and he/she may be authorized to utilize the funds available in one head of the expenditure for making payments in other heads, subject to availability of overall funds.

(ii) The expenditure incurred on the programmes may be debited from the fund allotted in the budgetary allocation under the head '**Training**' – 24-002.

VII. General Instructions:

1. The participants may not seek any adjustment or exemption unless it is a case of *vis-major*.

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2. The terms and conditions of the programme may be decided by the concerned District & Sessions Judges.
3. Principal District & Sessions Judge, may depute one suitable Judicial Officer/District Registrar posted at the headquarters for looking after all arrangements for the said programmes and he may be allowed to be paid per programme remuneration of ₹ 2,000/- and the Principal District & Sessions Judge may be paid remuneration of ₹ 2,500/- for engaging them in these Courses.
4. The officials of the District Court concerned [upto 4 (2 Class III and 2 Class IV)] whose services will be utilized for Programmes on holidays, an incentive of ₹ 1000/- to Class III employees and ₹ 300/- to Class IV employees may be allowed to be paid.
5. Guest faculties whose services are utilized for the purpose of the course, may be allowed to pay honorarium and travelling allowance as per High Court Order dated 26.08.2016 (**Annexure '1'**).
6. A report consisting of all the details like list of the participants, resource persons and the details of expenditure may be sent to MPSJA after the conduction of the programme.
7. All accounts in this regard and record of expenditures shall be duly maintained by the Officials of Accounts Department of the High Court of Madhya Pradesh with necessary co-ordination of the Officials of MPSJA.

General Instructions: The order of nomination may contain general instructions, terms and directions to be followed by the Resource Persons/ participants as per the proposal submitted by the Director, MPSJA to the Registrar General.
