

## MESSAGE

Dated : 15<sup>th</sup> March, 2016

Utmost care has been taken to follow the guidelines as per the Transfer Policy, 2016 before finalizing the places of posting on transfer. The representations regarding overstay or premature transfer have been considered by the Hon'ble Committee. On the recommendations of the Transfer Committee, for some Judicial Officers, overstay at present place or premature transfer is allowed as per the Policy.

During the transfer exercise, as directed, not only the guidelines of the Transfer Policy have been kept in mind, but in larger public interest for the smooth and effective Administration of Justice and to enhance excellence in the Judicial System and to ensure timeliness, some of the postings have been made at the places where large number of cases are pending to address the concern of the litigants/common men for whom we are serving.

In this process, perhaps some of the Judicial Officers have not been posted as per their choice of places but in the aforesaid circumstances, it was very difficult to fulfill the choice of all Judicial Officers affected by this holistic transfer exercise. Judicial Officers of the District Judiciary are bound to serve for Administration of Justice in the whole of the Madhya Pradesh where the subordinate Courts are functioning, whatever may be the place small or big town/city.
