Please refer to your application dt. 24.04.2019 received vide Inward No. 1053 dated 24.04.2019 & registered at our I.D. No. 04/2019-20 addressed to the undersigned regarding supply of information under Right to Information Act, 2005 As per the Application and as desired by you, the information can not be supplied due to the following reason:-

- 1. The competent Authority of High Court of M.P. has framed 'High Court of M.P. (Right to Information) Rules 2006' under Section 28(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005. In accordance with the provisions of Rule 7(1) of the said Rules 2006, a citizen/applicant is required to pay fee of Rs. 50/- in the form of non-judicial stamp or Treasury Challan, pasted with self-attested photograph (in original) of the applicant on Form 'A' and you have not filed the application in form no. A and failed to attest your photograph on it, instead you send e-Stamp hence failed to furnish the same, there for your application can not be entertained. The original India Non-Judicial e-Stamp vide Certificate No. IN-DL67528839244252R issued on 04 Apr-2019 is being returned to you in original.
- 2. As per Rule 3 (2) of the High Court of M.P. (Right to information) Rules 2006 every application shall be made for one particular item of information only but multiple information have been sought by you.

As per Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, you may file an appeal to the Appellate Authority (Principal Registrar, High Court of M.P., Indore Bench) within 30 days of the issue of this order.
