This appeal has been filed by the applicant being aggrieved by the order dated 21/02/18 passed by Shri Rajesh Sharma, Dy. Registrar-cum-State Public Information Officer, High Court of Madhya Pradesh, Bench at Indore, in ID No. RTI/DR-HCIND/.../2018.


The appellant sought information "**Copy of final order in case W.P. No. 3081/2017 in the case M/s Cummins Technologies India Pvt. Ltd. Vs. Union of India.**"

The SPIO by the impugned Order refused to give the information sought by the appellant citing rule 8 (1) of the High Court of M.P. (Right to Information) Rules, 2006 as amended. This rule 8 (1) provides that "State Public Information Officer shall not be liable to provide any information which can be obtained under the provision of Chapter XVIII of the High Court of M.P. Rules 2008.

As appellant has demanded copy of the final order in case W.P. No. 3081/2017 M/s Cummins Technologies India Pvt. Ltd. Vs. Union of India. The same cannot be provided because certified copy of the order can be obtained after paying proper copying fees from the copying section of the High Court.

Therefore, I find no infirmity in the order passed by the Learned SPIO. The appeal is without any substance and therefore, it is dismissed.

However, it is worth mentioning that the said order has been uploaded on official website i.e. www.mphc.in and the appellant can download the soft copy of the same order.
