- (1) Hon'ble the competent Authority of High Court of M.P. has framed 'High Court of M.P. (Right to Information) Rules 2006' under Section 28(1) of the Right to Information Act, 2005 and vide Order endt. No. E-30 dated 03.01.2017 made Amendments in the High Court of M.P. (Right to Information Rules, 2006. In accordance with the provisions of Rule 7(1) & (2) (Amended) of the said Rules 2006, ibid a citizen/applicant is required to pay fee of Rs. 50/- in the form of non judicial stamp or Treasury Challan, (including Cyber Treasury Challan) or payment through online portal (www.mphc.gov.in/e-rti) but you have not submitted duly filled up Form "A" pasted thereon your self attested photograph and enclosed one Indian Postal Order bearing no. 69E 486257 amounting to Rs. 10/- (instead of Non Judicial Stamp or Treasury Challan (including Cyber Treasury Challan of Rs.50/-) or payment through online portal (www.mphc.gov.in/e-rti), therefore, the application can not be entertained.
- (2) Moreover, as per the Rule 8(1) of the High Court of M.P. (Right to Information) Rule, 2006 as amended, State Public Information Officer shall not be liable to provide any information which can be obtained under the provisions of Chapter XVIII of the High Court of M.P. Rules, 2008 hence you are accordingly requested to contact Copying Section of this Bench Registry and apply for certified copies of the documents required by you after paying the proper copying fee.

As per Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, you may file an appeal to the Appellate Authority (Principal Registrar, High Court of M.P., Indore Bench) within 30 days of the issue of this order.
