
“Need/ Require one case registration number of writ petition (PIL) registered during year 1980 to 1990 with name bearing S.P. ANAND V/S. INDORE DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY” filed by Advocate Satypal Anand.

But the information desired by you cannot be supplied due to the following reasons:-

- (1) As per information Dated 13/05/2019 of Judicial Statistical Writer there are 124 Registration Registers of S.W. for the aforesaid period i.e. from 1980 to 1990 of the W.P. nature to trace out the same hence it will be insufficient to complete the task.
- (2) When information/record pertaining to a period of more than 29-39 years the best way of realization of right to information is to provide inspection. Because Inspection facilitates the appellant to pick up the relevant documents and seek copy of only those documents.

You are, therefore, requested to have inspection of the registers of S.W. and seek copies of papers, as per Rules, if you think necessary.

The As per Section 19 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, you may file an appeal to the Appellate Authority (Principal Registrar, High Court of M.P., Indore Bench) within 30 days of the issue of this order.
